Eligibility:

1. To be eligible, your video must be no longer than five (5) minutes in length.
2. Each contestant may only enter one original video, either alone or as part of a team effort.
3. Each contestant must certify on the entry form, that the video submission is an original work by the contestant or his/her team and must grant Alberta Employment and Immigration Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) unrestricted use and reproduction rights for any purpose.
4. Except for OHS employees and their immediate family members, this contest is open to all high school students residing in Alberta.
5. Your video must be entirely your (or in the case of a team effort, your team's) own original creation. It must not infringe upon or violate any laws or any third-party rights, including, but not limited to, copyright, patent, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary rights and must not lead to any cause of action including libel, defamation, privacy violation, contract breach or tort. Contestants must obtain all necessary permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and other approvals from third parties (including but not limited to all copyright holders and all individuals appearing in the video submission), necessary to use the video submission, in whole or in part, in any way, including without limitation, to reproduce, make derivatives, edit, modify, translate, distribute, transmit, publish, license and broadcast the video submission worldwide, by any means. Any and all such permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and approvals must be attached with your video entry.

General Information:

6. Your own personal safety and the safety of your cast, crew and others involved with the production of the video submission must be maintained. Do not endanger anyone during the making of your video. If you are on a work site, take all appropriate health and safety precautions including without limitation following all applicable health and safety policies and regulations. You may wish to consult with a supervisor or other competent individual at the site to obtain this information.
7. No entries will be returned. All winning entries become the sole property of OHS.
8. Three prizes will be awarded in this contest. A prize of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) Canadian will be awarded to the first place entry. A prize of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750) Canadian will be awarded to the second place entry. A prize of five hundred dollars (\$500) Canadian will be awarded to the third place entry. Matching prizes are awarded to the high schools of the winning entries.
9. Before collecting a prize, each individual or team member involved in the creation of a winning entry, and, in the case of those individuals or team members who have not yet reached the age of majority, his/her parent or legal guardian will be required to sign a standard declaration and release form confirming compliance with the contest rules, and acceptance of the prize as awarded and assigning all

- rights, titles and interests in the entry to OHS (including a waiver of moral rights) within seven (7) days of being notified that his/her entry has been selected.
10. If a contestant is not 18 years old, OHS will require his or her parent's or legal guardian's authorization before permitting the contestant to participate in the contest and accept a prize as awarded. In the case of a team effort, each member of the team who is not 18 years old must also obtain parental or guardian consent.
 11. When entering this contest, each contestant (and where appropriate, with the consent of a parent or guardian) must consent to the use, reproduction, publication, transmission and/or broadcasting of his/her name, address, likeness, school, age, grade and/or prize information, without compensation, in any OHS advertisement, publication or promotion, for general news or other information purposes. Winners must also consent to their photographs being taken by OHS for the same purposes, without further compensation. Each contestant (and where required, his/her parent or guardian) irrevocably and in perpetuity grants OHS, without compensation, the right to use the video submission, in whole or in part, in any way, including without limitation, to reproduce, make derivatives, edit, modify, translate, distribute, transmit, publish, license and broadcast the video submission worldwide, by any means.
 12. The chances of winning a prize depend on the total number and quality of eligible entries received prior to the closing date.
 13. OHS reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest for any reason, without any prior notice to any contestant.

Selection of Awards:

14. In the case of a team effort, OHS may issue pro-rated cheque(s) to each team member. Each winning high school will receive a matching prize equal to the total prize awarded to the team.
15. Entries will be judged by a panel of judges chosen by OHS. The decisions of the judges on all matters relating to the contest are final and not open to dispute.
16. Each individual or team member who submitted a winning entry will be notified by telephone that his/her entry has won and the procedure to follow to claim the applicable prize. If an individual or one or more team members decline the prize, the prize may be forfeited and awarded to another entry in accordance with these contest rules. A list of winning videos will be posted on the employment.alberta.ca and you-tube.
17. If OHS does not receive entries of sufficient quantity or quality, OHS reserves the right not to award any prizes.

Entry Information:

18. Each contestant or team may only submit one video submission in DVD-R format. Multiple entries will not be accepted.
19. Your video submission must be received by OHS by **4:00 pm on Friday, February 10, 2012**. You will not be contacted to confirm your submission has been received.

21. The video entry must be clearly labeled with your video's title, your name, mailing address and telephone number. Where more than one student has been involved in the creation of the video, the video entry must be clearly labeled as a team effort.
22. Include your completed Official Entry Form with your video submission. If the entry is a team effort, page 2 of the Official Entry Form must be completed and returned with your entry.
23. If any copyright or permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and approvals were obtained, please enclose these with your video entry. OHS is not responsible for entries which are delayed, lost, misdirected, incomplete, damaged or destroyed. Any entry that is tampered with, unreadable or mutilated will not be accepted. **PLEASE SEND OHS A DUPLICATE COPY OF YOUR ENTRY. DO NOT SEND YOUR ONLY COPY.**
24. For the purpose of these Rules, each properly labeled video submission accompanied by a properly completed Official Entry Form shall be considered a valid entry.
25. These rules may be changed without notice or reason including, if necessary, to comply with any applicable law. By entering this contest, contestants agree to abide by these rules and acknowledge that OHS shall not be responsible for any damages, costs, demands, claims or losses of any kind, incurred by any contestant as a result of participation in the Work Safe Alberta Student Video Contest.
26. This contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta and any applicable federal laws. These rules govern all aspects of the contest and are binding on all contestants and all other participants including parents, legal guardians and team members, who sign the Official Entry Form.
